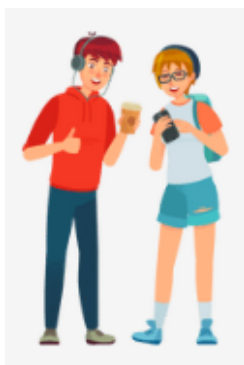

Write at least 25 words.





